


WJ Group Global Structure








Member companies employ more than 600 drillers (Approximately 60% of all drillers)


In the last 12 months the BDA Audit has been thoroughly overhauled and the most significant changes introduced since its inception:



Audit designed around GI to meet requirement for annual audit for competence in accordance with BS22475 & Yellow Book

90% of Audit content is highly relevant to any drilling operation – water wells, geothermal, drilling and grouting. Objective to introduce Endorsements for these disciplines by Q1 2022



Non GI Audits = 10% of all audits

In the last 12 months c190 Lead Drillers have been audited which is an uplift from Audited c140 in the year 2019 - 20. Putting its mission statement into action

 The BDA is committed to improving standards in Health & Safety, Quality & Technical Proficiency in the drilling industry.

How can the BDA fulfil its mission statement?

The BDA believes that an annual audit helps demonstrate competence, meet legal obligations and ensure compliance with industry standards

From the start of 2023 it is proposed that to qualify for membership of the BDA a company must achieve minimum 60% compliance of Lead Drillers having an in date Audit and demonstrate commitment to aim for 100% compliance.

Companies who do not achieve this level of compliance will have Membership revoked

How do you select a driller? Is drilling co company quality management system or self certification really evidence of driller competence? Would you accept an electrician without qualification?

Membership of the BDA means more than a pre-qualification tick box



Audit is evidence of your businesses commitment to raise standards in quality and health & safety and compliance with fundamental legislation.

Audit is evidence of your business commitment to train, mentor, engage with and increase the knowledge and skills of your operatives

Audit is great value for money – cost of employment for a Lead Driller incl. salary, NI, travel, subsistence, van, PPE, training, phone etc equivalent to £80 – 100k per year. Audit cost = 0.5% of cost of employment





Audit is evidence of operative competence – competent staff prevents accidents and non conformance – improved business performance
