



MCS Governance



Administered by Gemserv

- Arranging meetings
- Maintain website
- Email and 'phone helpdesks



- The name
 - Simplified from "Microgeneration Certification Scheme" to "MCS"
- The logo (& strapline)









- Charges for installers agreed by the Steering Group
 - £100 per year
 - £5 per installation
- Charges for products on a sliding scale
 - -£350 /£250 /£175 /£100
- Does not include Certification Body fees

- New Certification Bodies are being accredited by UKAS
 - BRE (already accredited)
 - NICEIC (already accredited for solar thermal & heat pumps installers)
 - Action Renewables (Installer)
 - BBA (Installers and product)
 - BSI (Product)
 - CORGI (Installers)
 - EC Certification / ELECSA (Installers)
 - HETAS (Installers and product)
 - NAPIT (Installers)
 - TUV NEL (Wind product)



- Steering Group to be replaced by a Panel
 - Chairman currently being elected
- Various Working Groups continue to meet to finalise or review MCS documents
- A Products Workshop was held to consider product families and MCS FPC requirements



Current Position

- There are 95 GSHP installers accredited under MCS
- 57 GSHP products accredited under MCS
- 114 GSHPs are accredited under ClearSkies
 - These will need to become MCS accredited by the end of the year
- Total of 304 MCS installers
